



FIREARMS/TACTICAL HANDGUN ADV (PSP)

For Law Enforcement Officers only

An eight-hour course designed to allow students to improve their shooting skills and practice tactical decision making, while using their primary firearm. Students will receive some lecture on force options, case law, legal and moral issues and firearms tactics. Students will practice (live fire) tactically, using their primary firearm and using good judgment during a firearm encounter. Students will also practice decision making skills during incidents involving the use of firearms. This course will satisfy the eight-hour requirement of Perishable Skills Program training, as set forth by POST, for *Tactical Firearms Training*.
